School Year Commitments

B-Days: 7th Period PreDrill

During the school day, the PreDrill class period will primarily focus on Belles prep & dance technique. Our goal is to utilize this class period to prepare members for Trojan Belle auditions as much as possible in order to increase confidence, stamina, and overall dance ability. Please ask for prior approval for any absence, and we ask that every effort be made to schedule doctor's appointments at alternate times.

A-Days: PreDrill Practices

These practices will be on A-Days from 7:00-8:35am. We will use this rehearsal time to perfect routines that will be performed at halftime of a varsity football game and Fall Dance Concert. Attendance is mandatory & all tutorials should be scheduled either before school on B-days, during FIT, or after school.

ONE Football Game in the Fall

This will be a home game and will likely be held at an AISD Field at 7:30pm. More information will be provided as soon as the football schedule is finalized. The Anderson High School Dance Department puts on an annual department-wide performance in the AHS Performing Arts Center every year. The dress rehearsal for this performance will be considered a 'field trip' during the morning of the show, and there will be two performances in the evening to ensure all friends & family get a chance to see the performances—this show sells out every year!

Mandatory Parent Informational Meeting

During this meeting, we will go through the audition packet, discuss what to expect during the week of tryouts, and answer any and all questions you may have about tryouts & Belles! *One parent AND the Belle-hopeful must be in attendance* in order to be eligible to audition for Trojan Belles. Trojan Belles Auditions

During the week of tryouts, the girls will learn a jazz dance & a kick dance before school on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. Mock auditions will be held on Thursday morning in the Dance Gym and Formal auditions will be held after school on Thursday. This entire week is mandatory for all hopefuls trying out and all events are closed to the public.

Spring Semester

PreDrill members that make Belles will use the spring semester to learn traditional football routines. PreDrill members that do not make Belles will stay in 7th Period (the gym will be split in 2) so that they can continue to work on dance and kick technique without having to adjust their schedules.

Required Items

Fair Share: \$200 for new members, \$100 for returners

What does Fair Share include?

- Uniform Costs

- Includes:

- Black High Waisted Leggings (to keep)
- Tan Jazz Shoes (to keep)
- Body tights (to keep)
- Uniform Top, poms (checked in and out at every performance)
- Bag to take to football games (checked out at the beginning of the year)
- Four practice tops (to keep or donate back to the program)
- Bus transportation to football games
- Meals prior to football games
- Large water jug for long practices & football games (to keep)

Fair Share due date: July 29th

All Students participating in PreDrill are expected to pay fair share by the July 29th deadline. This payment can be made with cash or a check made out to Anderson High School with *PreDrill* in the memo line. Failure to meet the due date OR contact the director, Cierra Birmingham, in advance can result in the student's removal from participation. **However, no student will be denied participation due to a family's inability to pay.** We incur many costs in advance on students' behalf. For this reason, there can be no refunds due to ineligibility or change of schedule, as expenses are pre-paid. Plan well in advance and pass your classes! **Parents of any student with financial difficulty must contact the director by email in advance of any due date affected for an extension. **Communication is key!**

Rehearsal Rules & Expectations

1. If you are not at rehearsal, you should not expect to perform.
2. A member must be present at all rehearsals from Monday through Friday unless previous arrangements are made with the director.
3. Work cannot interfere with scheduled rehearsals. Work is not an excused absence from rehearsal or an excuse to leave early or arrive late.
4. Regular doctor, dentist, or driving exam appointments should not interfere with any rehearsals scheduled. These appointments are not excused. Emergency appointments are treated with an exception.
5. If a member is absent or tardy to a rehearsal, performance or work session, she is held responsible for all announcements, information missed, and deadlines.
6. A member may be pulled from a performance due to missing a practice depending on the circumstance, time of year, and proximity to the performance.
7. You CANNOT miss the Wednesday or Thursday rehearsal leading up to a football performance and still perform UNLESS there is an extenuating circumstance (i.e.- field trip, funeral)
8. We expect you to fully dedicate your time during rehearsal. No breakfast, homework, or studying will be permitted during the scheduled rehearsal hours. This includes warm-up. We expect you to be ready to go when you arrive.
9. Sitting out for illness or injury during a rehearsal may result in being pulled from a performance. If a member is truly injured or ill, it is in her best interest and the team's that she not rehearse or perform until she is well. If a dancer is to get hurt in class, it is important that they communicate to the fullest what happened and what they are feeling. We aim to help address each issue before it has the opportunity to get worse, but can only do so if the dancer advocates for themselves to help us better understand what is going on.

Eligibility

The state law is such that a student shall be suspended from participation in all extracurricular activities sponsored or sanctioned by the school district during the nine-week period following a grade reporting period in which the student received a grade lower than seventy in any one class. Ineligible students **ARE** still required to attend all rehearsals and performances, but **ARE NOT** permitted to perform in football pre-game performances. Students that are ineligible to perform will be given an alternate assignment to make up for the missed grades. We will be conducting regular grade checks throughout the grading period in hopes of minimizing the number of ineligible members in PreDrill, but you are ultimately responsible for keeping up with your work and grades.

**We will be having grade checks throughout the year. If a dancer is to fail one or more classes at report cards, they will be sent home with a paper for a parent or guardian to sign to ensure that the dancer, teacher, and parent/guardian are on the same page. This dancer will also lose eligibility and has the opportunity to regain it at the following progress report. If the dancer is not passing at this point, they will lose eligibility for the remainder of the nine weeks.*

***Please be aware that this is a **PreDrill requirement** in order to help ensure that all dancers are not only passing, but also excelling in each class to help better prepare for requirements in future endeavors, such as Trojan Belles Tryouts.*

Grading Policy

Zero Hour

Daily Grades (50% of Total):

Students will start every rehearsal with 100 points for their daily grade. The following will result in lost points:

- -25 pts: tardy
- -25 pts: incorrect practice attire
- -25 pts: wearing jewelry
- -25 pts: chewing gum
- -100 pts: unexcused absence
- Points may also be deducted for behavioral issues, missed deadlines, and forgotten items as needed.

Test Grades (50% of Total):

Each performance will be considered one test grade. The grading is not performance based. Students will lose points for forgotten items and uniform pieces, misbehavior in the stands/on the bus, and tardiness.

7th Period

Daily Grades (50% of Total):

Students will start every rehearsal with 100 points for their daily grade. The following will result in lost points:

- -25 pts: tardy
- -25 pts: incorrect practice attire
- -25 pts: wearing jewelry
- -25 pts: chewing gum
- -100 pts: unexcused absence
- Points may also be deducted for behavioral issues, missed deadlines, and forgotten items as needed.

Test Grades (50% of Total):

We will have 2-3 skill exams during each grading period. These skill exams are designed to help prepare members for Trojan Belle auditions at the end of the semester. Each skill exam will provide individualized feedback for every member of PreDrill to ensure continuous growth in dance technique and confidence throughout the semester.
